

OUR YEAR

2017 was one for the record books in some good ways and some not so great ways. In the past year, we distributed more food than ever to our neighbors in need, we rescued more produce from South Georgia growers and packers, and we fed more kids than ever before through Kids Cafe. On the flip side, we had to respond to more disasters (both at home and across the Southeast) than at any time in our history. We are proud of all we have accomplished this past year, and we are grateful to all the donors and supporters who helped make that happen.

OUR WORK

The mission of Second Harvest of South Georgia is feeding those in need; our vision is a South Georgia without hunger. This sounds simple, but hunger is a plague on this area. Our service region has the highest rates of food insecurity in the state and among the highest in the nation. We work with more than 450 partner agencies and operate a variety of programs including the food bank, Kids' Cafe, Farm to Family, Teachers' Harvest, and our Mobile Food Pantry. In this area, nearly 1 in 4 people struggle with hunger including 1 in 3 South Georgia children.




2017 FINANCIALS


Second Harvest of South Georgia, a qualified 501 (c)(3) organization, utilizes 97.13% of every donation to support our program services which include the Food Bank, Kids Cafe, Mobile Food Pantry, Product Recovery, Farm to Family and Teachers' Harvest.
