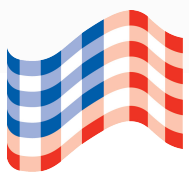

Our Mission: Feeding Those in Need

Second Harvest of South Georgia is the region's leading hunger-relief organization and the largest rural food bank in the state.

We serve a 26-county, nearly 12,000 square mile area, with headquarters in Valdosta and branches in Thomasville and Tifton. We support more than 300 partner agencies through programs like the Food Bank, Kids Cafe, Mobile Food Pantry, and Teachers' Harvest.





Here's How We Are Fighting Hunger

We serve 26 counties with some of the highest poverty and food insecurity rates in Georgia and the nation.

Kids Cafe

Nearly 430,000 meals served to children last year, including 120,000 during just the summer months.

Partnerships

More than 20M meals worth of food distributed last year through our partner agencies.

Teachers' Harvest

School supplies distributed to thousands of students and hundreds of classrooms, supporting classroom success for teachers and students.

Senior Boxes

1,350 monthly pantry boxes to area seniors in need, helping them stay nourished and self-sufficient.

Volunteers

5,700 volunteer hours served last year by 1,200 dedicated volunteers, generating an economic impact of nearly \$200,000.



In 2025, Second Harvest moved into a brand-new, expanded facility. This marked a major step forward in our mission to fight hunger across South Georgia.

The larger, more efficient space significantly increases our capacity to receive, store, and distribute food. It allows us to serve more families and respond more quickly to growing needs.

With improved infrastructure and room to scale our operations, we're better equipped than ever. We can better support our network of partner agencies and ensure more meals reach the communities that need them most.





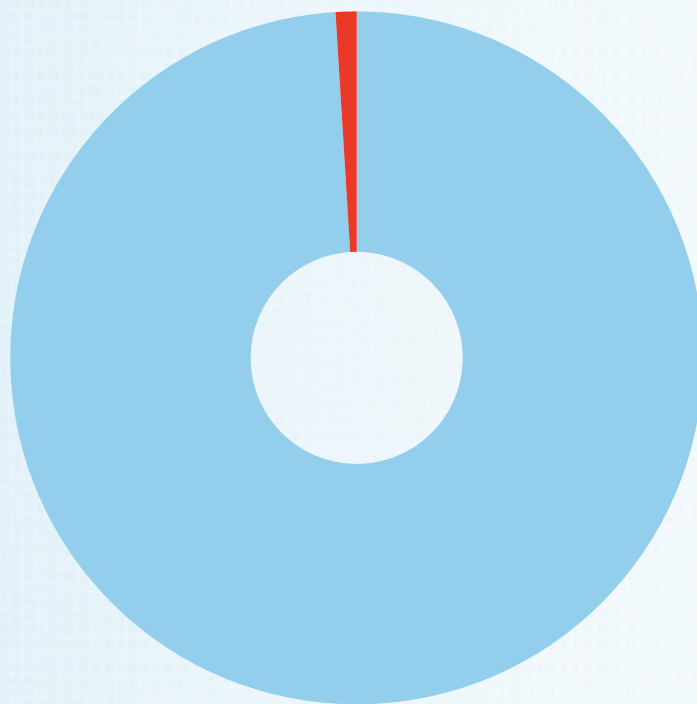
